The Role

In addition, she/he will coordinate and supervise the contributions from the Innovation Factory and Accelerator Teams.

Main Responsibilities

- Coordinate and supervise implementation of the existing EIT Digital collaboration agreements with other EU
 organizations through concrete activities;
- Deliver on the financial and impact KPIs, as defined in the respective collaboration agreements;
- Drive activities on behalf of EIT Digital, acting as the single point of contact;
- Instruct the EIT Digital project-teams to deliver timely and tangible results within these activities, with a focus on impact generation, stakeholder satisfaction and operational excellence;
- Manage the operational aspects of the corresponding budgets;
- Provide regular updates to the Chief Innovation Officer and the EIT Digital management including analytics, dashboarding, forecasts and business presentations;
- Provide timely reporting in the context of the EIT Digital processes;
- Nurture the relationship with other EU organizations to facilitate renewal, extension and definition of new collaboration agreements.
