

# Strong momentum. Doubling down on our long-term vision. 7-month streak

Here is EIT Digital's Q2 in a nutshell.





Dear partners and friends of EIT Digital,

Together, we are undertaking the biggest transformation in EIT Digital's history. Everything we have achieved in Q2 and all long-term projects that we are preparing are a testament to our progress. Not only did we meet all top and bottom-line expectations for the quarter, but we kept the strong momentum from Q1 and managed to grow our ecosystem. The keyword is together - with our colleagues, partners, new players in our ecosystem and the public sector: Member States, EU Institutions, bodies and agencies. We're playing in a spot that has a commercial leg (we are investing in startups, acceleration services and educational programmes) and a strategic partnership leg (focusing on the Horizon Europe and Digital Europe programmes and more). Unlike other specialised organisations in the tech and public sectors, EIT Digital sits in the middle, connecting and effectively bridging the two.

On the **innovation and entrepreneurship** front, as part of the early-stage startup boosting programme, the top 8 startups have started their innovation activities within the EIT Digital Open Innovation Factory. Good luck <u>Binarii Labs</u>, <u>thinkers.ai</u>, <u>3visionD</u>, <u>Simplyblock</u>, <u>Rentall</u>, <u>eMoodie</u>, <u>CINTERACTION</u>, <u>Detectium</u>.

The Speed Master's very first edition kicked-off this week! More than 50 entrepreneurs representing over 30 European startups operating in MedTech, blockchain, green digital, mobility, InsurTech, quantum computing and FinTech are taking a **4-month executive course** on strategy, management, business development and access to finance. All this while <u>ARIADNE</u>, an Open Innovation Factory alumnus, raised \$7 million in a Series A round.

The 2023 edition of the Venture Program kicked off and the first demo days and training sessions were organised by our Partners. A batch of newly created ventures had the opportunity to pitch at <u>WMF - We Make Future</u>.

3 of the scaleups that participated in the <u>EIC – EIT Digital Venture Acceleration</u> Programme raised series A. Congratulations to: <u>Sensoneo</u> (€6.2 million), <u>Mitiga</u> <u>Solutions</u> (€13.25 million) and Robotec.

We are looking forward continuing our collaboration with the <u>European Innovation</u> <u>Council and SMEs Executive Agency</u> (EISMEA)

We selected the winners of the <u>EIT Digital Challenge</u>, these 10 companies have the opportunity to work with the <u>EIT Digital Growth Services</u> team for one year.

On the **strategic partnerships** front, our Budapest, Eindhoven and Madrid offices kicked off their respective <u>European Digital Innovation Hub</u> (EDIH) projects.

Together with our Partners, we have been awarded 4 new EU Projects (for a total of 7 since the beginning of the year), submitted another 20 and started the preparation of more than 20 additional proposals to be submitted in Q3 and Q4.

In particular, two new Digital Europe programme projects are particularly relevant for the #EuropeanYearOfSkills:

- SPECTRO is Specialised Education programmes in Cybersecurity and Robotics and will focus on the design and delivery of two double-degree master's programmes (ISCED Level 7, 120 ECTS) in two key digital technology areas for the future of Europe: 1) Cybersecurity and 2) Robotics.
- Emotion Artificial Intelligence specialists for Europe (EMAI4EU) aims to train the next generation of specialists and innovators in Emotion Artificial Intelligence in Europe.

However, this is not enough. We are currently building strong consortia for the **Regional Innovation Valleys** (both the Interconnected Innovation Ecosystems and the Interregional Innovation Investments Strand 1 and Strand 2a). Take a look at our call to action in the newsletter section below, and partner with us.

#### On the entrepreneurial education front:

- A next cohort of future tech leaders and digital entrepreneurs will start in September: we have 180+ students admitted to the <u>Master School</u>, benefitting from 15 European top tech universities' programmes in 9 countries.
- Going deep in the entrepreneurship component of the educational

programme, students are solving real life business challenges in the 11 <u>Summer Schools</u>.

In terms of **ecosystem development**, our annual conference <u>GrowDigital23</u> brought together digital innovators from all over Europe, 32 of our startups showcased their impressive tech and 30+ speakers amazed us with their insights. Thank you for participating and if you did not do so; watch the <u>highlights</u> and re-live the experience of my <u>keynote and our panel discussions</u>!

Moreover, we are expanding our footprint as we are opening regional offices in **Thessaloniki** and **Cluj-Napoca** in the next months and in the meantime partnered with the <u>European Business Angel Network</u> to better support Europe's early-stage startups. Two of the largest ecosystems come together for European development.

Our agreement with <u>Scottish Enterprise</u> was extended to maintain our activities in Scotland.

Finally, we had the privilege to explore collaboration opportunities, synergies and new EIT Digital office prospects with stakeholders in Serbia and Bulgaria.

Overall, I couldn't be more excited about the future and where we're going. Once again: thanks to our partners and colleagues for your dedication to our ongoing success. Special thanks to my colleagues doing remarkable work every day.

#### Where we made an impact

#### Working together with the European Innovation Council

Following the establishment of the European Innovation Council (EIC), we at EIT Digital have been working closer supporting the deep tech startup and scaleup ecosystem with great results.

The recent successes of in particular three companies, all participants in the EIC-

EIT Digital Venture Acceleration Program, highlight the potential and increasingly important role played by European SMEs in the deep tech sector.

<u>Sensoneo</u>, a smart waste management solutions provider, recently announced a successful <u>Series A funding round amounting to €6.2 million</u>. In the climate tech domain, EIT Digital-supported scaleup <u>Mitiga Solutions</u> has raised <u>€13.25 million in</u> <u>Series A funding</u>, set to be used for expanding its talent pool and enhancing its risk modelling capabilities.

AgTech startup <u>Robotec</u> has also reaped the benefits of DeepTech investment. This family-run company from Bremen successfully secured a multi-million financing round last December.

#### From the spotlight of the European Central Bank

The EIT Digital Accelerator alumnus <u>Squirro</u> from Switzerland has recently made headlines! Squirro supported the European Central Bank (ECB) in <u>winning Central</u> <u>Banking FinTech RegTech Global Awards 2023 in the Al category</u>!

Squirro's new natural language processing (NLP) artificial intelligence (AI) tool "Athena," will allow over 1,000 supervisors to analyze more than 5 million documents across the Single Supervisory Mechanism (SSM). A solution approved by the Eurosystem Procurement Coordination Office (EPCO).
