With a master's degree in Environment and Development from Kings College, London, he has also helped shape and deliver UK government policy in roles with the Department of Communities and Local Government and the Homes and Communities Agency.

Dennis has extensive experience in smart cities, smart energy systems, and enterprise computing, and has helped lead the successful launch of a venture funded startup. He has also shaped and led several EIT and Framework Programme activities.
