EIT Digital Summer Schools are an integrated part of the Master School and a key effort in the innovation and entrepreneurship part of the curricula. Today 300 EIT Digital master students attend one of the 10 two-week Summer Schools all around Europe. The Summer Schools' content and innovation and business cases are deeply embedded in the EIT Digital Innovation Action Lines (Digital Cities, Digital Finance, Digital Industry, Digital Infrastructure, Digital Wellbeing).

Today, doctoral and master students from other universities and industrial employees looking for expanding their innovation and entrepreneurship competencies also join the Summer Schools as external participants.

To further increase the impact of our successful Summer Schools we strive to significantly increase the number of non-EIT Digital participation. We aim to increase the number of Summer Schools and to balance the participation to 50/50 with a target for the 2018 Summer Schools to enrol 300 EIT Digital master students and 300 external learners.

Key responsibilities



- Further develop the Summer Schools towards a sustainable activity serving the EIT
 Digital Master School students as well as external paying participants
- Drive this development and execution of the Summer Schools in close cooperation with Action Line Leaders, Master School Head and EIT Digital partners (university, research centers, and increasingly industry).
- Design a business model and growth strategy to significantly grow the number of paying external participants in the EIT Digital Summer Schools to achieve at least self-financing
- Direct marketing and sales campaigns (with support of the Marketing & Sales team)

Qualifications

We are looking for a senior Summer School Head. The Summer School Head should have an industrial background with a technical academic education. The Head should be entrepreneurial and communicative. We expect:

- At least 10 years experience in developing and directing commercial education programmes
- Minimally MSc degree in ICT or STEM (preferably PhD) complemented by industry experience in the field of ICT
- Experience with complex multi-actor organisational processes
- Experience from international collaboration and public-private partnerships
- Understanding of legal, fiscal and financial aspects
- Excellent management skills with operational excellence focus and hands-on mentality
- Excellent leadership and communication skills
