- In computing: cloud computing, big data, artificial intelligence

- In networking: mobile broadband, 'softwarisation', internet of things

The Role

The Action Line Leader is responsible on the one hand for shaping the future Action Line portfolio, and on the other hand, for managing of the portfolio of current innovation activities.

The position requires technology intimacy and vision in Digital Infrastructure topics, as well as operational excellence and leadership skills. Superior communication skills in English are extremely important for this position.

Key Responsibilities

1. Proactively scouting and extracting promising technologies out of the EIT Digital ecosystem and shaping them into Minimal Viable Products (MVPs) and/or startups together with the adequate EIT Digital partners (technology/architecture orientation);
2. Daily management of the portfolio of innovation activities – driving them to deliver on milestones, KPIs and sustainability commitments (program management orientation).

In addition, the Action Line Leader needs to support the integration of "Education, Research and Business" by defining internships, post-master topics, as well as summer school and PhD position topics.
