The Position

Digital Finance is an area that has attracted a significant amount of investments in the last few years and is the newest Innovation Action Line for EIT Digital.

Reporting to the Chief Research & Innovation Officer, the Action Line Leader is responsible for the market impact and financial sustainability of his or her portfolio of innovation activities. The position requires leadership and program management skills as well as operational excellence on building, executing and harvesting from innovation activities.

 - Orchestrate the design of the Action Line portfolio in close collaboration with Node Directors and EIT Digital Partner organisations
 - Drive & impact
 - Drive activity leaders to concretely deliver on their activity milestones and KPIs
 - Drive the market impact of innovation activities with dissemination efforts, customer, stakeholder and investor acquisition etc.
 - Succeed & harvest
 - Drive activity leaders to concretely deliver on their sustainability commitments
 - Monitor, act & report
 - Manage daily operational issues and lead the contractual aspects with portfolio activities on behalf of EIT Digital
 - Report on innovation activity results in terms of KPIs, achievements and success stories including in the context of EIT Digital processes
2. Support the integration of Education, Research and Business
 - Integrate EIT Digital Accelerator scaleups in the Action Line when appropriate

- Guarantee that the portfolio defines an appropriate set of internships for master students
- Provide the Action Line content for the summer schools
- Drive a good inflow of mature research results into the innovation activities

- Delivery on ROI/sustainability commitments of innovation activities
- Involvement of students in innovation activities
- Inflow of mature research results into the Action Line
- Number of tier-1 communications of Action Line results in collaboration with EIT Digital Communications
