The Position

The Co-Location Centre Manager has the overall responsibility for the Helsinki Co-Location Centre, which means the CLC operations, including administrative/financial, reporting and logistical aspects. The CLC Manager takes the lead in making the CLC a lively and vibrant environment, fostering Education/Research/Business integration and multidisciplinary team cross-pollination, in order to stimulate entrepreneurship in innovation and education. The CLC Manager is also responsible for supporting Node-

specific activities and EIT Digital Action Line activities in a collaborative manner with the Node Director and the EIT Digital Action Line Leaders.

The Co-Location Centre Manager reports to the Node Director in Finland. The position is full-time and will be based in Espoo, Finland.

Responsibilities

- Overall operational responsibility of the CLC and its resources
- Align Co-Location policy and support to the EIT Digital strategy and activities
- Engage in the Node Team activities (e.g. CLC internal meetings)
- Facilitate the on-boarding of EIT Digital employees and welcoming of short/long-term visitors
- Planning and management of office spaces and relevant logistic aspects for the CLC (e.g. contracts for rent, refurbishment and IT infrastructures)
- Provide organisational and operational support for the EIT Digital Node and Action Line activities, events and workshops at the CLC, such as Innovation Days, Innovation and Accelerator Initiatives, Education Activities (e.g. Doctoral Training Centres, Summer Schools, Master School Activities, Professional School Activities), Post-Master activities, Call for Proposals related activities
- Provide support to EIT Digital events in the Node external to the CLC
- Collaborate with the other EIT Digital CLC Managers across Europe, including sharing of best practices

Qualifications

- Education: Bachelor/Master degree in a relevant discipline (e.g. Administration, Business, Engineering)
- Work experience: 5+ years of relevant experience; work experience across organisations and/or work experience in an international organisation is a plus
- Experience of managing a team/coordinating with internal and external stakeholders
- Sound understanding of administrative processes, financial and legal matters; experience of administration in EU-funded activities is a plus
- Excellent organisational skills, including logistic aspects
- Experience in events planning, organisation and execution
