The Role

The CEdO is expected to interact at a strategic level with the partners that contribute to the EIT Digital Academy, in close collaboration with the Node Directors.

Responsibilities

EIT Digital looks for a Chief Education Officer with an excellent academic educational background complemented with industrial and European (international) experience. The CEdO's main responsibilities are:

- Daily management of the EIT Digital Academy with a focus on operational excellence;
- Development of EIT Digital education strategy in line with the overall EIT Digital Strategy, and document this in the EIT Digital SIA;
- Drive the evolution and expansion of the EIT Digital education program, as well as its impact, role and profile in Europe;
- Supervise the recruitment and admission processes of the various schools in the EIT Digital Academy;

- Assure the quality of the EIT Digital Academy schools, amongst others via the EIT Label;
- Pursue additional funding streams at national level, in collaboration with Node Directors;
- Work with the EIT Digital Head of Communication to ensure high visibility of the program;
- Propose the yearly budget, monitor its evolution and provide timely reporting as required by EIT Digital and EIT.

Qualifications

- At least 10+ years of experience at senior academic level (dean, vice-president of education) in education management, with international experience, where industry experience is an advantage;
- PhD in ICT, or STEM with extensive experience in ICT education
- Proven track record in academic and/or industrial innovation and R&D

- Communication and reporting skills at executive level
