EIT Digital seeks to generate significant 'deep tech' innovations from top European research results. Our objective is the development, market uptake and business growth of these innovations. We strategically focus on 5 Innovation Action Lines (Digital Industry, Digital Cities, Digital Wellbeing, Digital Finance and Digital Infrastructure).

In all Action Lines, many of the innovation activities (including the strategic AAA activities) create ventures as an outcome of the activity, with EIT Digital as a co-investor holding equity positions in these ventures.

The Role

The Venture Portfolio Manager is responsible for designing, realizing and protecting the EIT Digital equity positions and reporting to management on the EIT Digital venture portfolio.

The role requires hands-on experience in tech startup creation and venture portfolio management, as well as operational excellence (process orientation, attention to detail, reporting).

Key Responsibilities

The venture portfolio manager is the key accountable person in all stages of venture-creating activities at EIT Digital.

- 1. During the design of the activities, the venture portfolio manager drives venture-creating opportunities and their operational implementation with a commitment on equity positions for EIT Digital.
- 2. When the activities are running, the venture portfolio manager supervises the process towards the creation of the venture and is accountable on driving the process on behalf of EIT Digital as a shareholder.
- Once the ventures are created, the venture portfolio manager drives the portfolio of ventures (e.g. with respect to shareholding obligations, admin and legal processes) and regularly reports on the portfolio to management.

- Number of ventures created annually with equity positions for EIT Digital
- Growth metrics of the venture portfolio (venture capital funds attracted, customers signed up, headcount, aggregate revenues)
- Success stories and tier-1 communications on venture portfolio
