EIT Digital helps business and entrepreneurs to be at the frontier of digital innovation by providing them with technology, talent, and growth support.

The Position

The Director is the figure head of EIT Digital in the Benelux and drives the development of the partnership and the execution of the EIT Digital activities in the Benelux. The Director manages the Benelux Legal Entity and its team, is a member of the EIT Digital Management Committee, and collaborates closely with the EIT Digital C-level officers as well as with the EIT Digital Innovation Leaders and School Heads. The Node Director reports to the CEO of EIT Digital.

Responsibilities

- Management of the EIT Digital Benelux Node daily operations and direct reports;
- Together with the Node Strategy Committee develop EIT Digital Benelux into an active, impactful, and recognised stronghold of EIT Digital in the Benelux, including the development of the partnership of EIT Digital in the Benelux;
- Align closely with and support the EIT Digital education and innovation leaders to guarantee operational excellence from the national partners in the education and innovation activities of the EIT Digital Action Lines in order to deliver on EIT Digital KPIs;
- Make the Co-location Centre in Eindhoven and the satellite Co-location Centres in Amsterdam and Antwerp a lively and vibrant place with multidisciplinary teams cross-pollinate including hosting startups;
- Act as the account manager to the EIT Digital Benelux partnership including business intros:
- Contribute to EIT Digital sustainability through acquisition of national and regional financial support for the EIT Digital operations in the Benelux amongst others via liaison with national Innovation programs.

Qualifications

- Strong managerial industrial experience (15+ years) in development and execution of digital innovation strategies with industry, start-ups, scaleups, universities, and research institutes
- Track record in acquisition of private and public national and/or regional innovation financing
- Strong network in the Benelux (Business, VCs, Incubators, Innovation Centres, Universities)
- Strong international experience, especially in working with European multi-stake holder organizations.
